AQUANIMA COOKIE POLICY



1. Responsible entity

By way of this notice, IBÉRICA DE COMPRAS CORPORATIVAS, S.L., a Spanish company with registered address at Avda. De Cantabria S/N, Edificio Arrecife, Planta 0, 28660 Boadilla del Monte, Madrid, with Tax ID number B-82797713 and registered in the Mercantile Registry of Madrid volume 15,946, Book 0, Section 8, page M-269630, and owner of *this website* ("AQUANIMA" or the "Editor", indistinctly), informs the users of the website www.aquanima.com ("the Website" and "the User or the Users") about its Cookie Policy, so that they understand the cookies that will be used while they browse the Website and can consent to their use

2. What are cookies?

Cookies are files that are downloaded and stored on the devices (computer/smartphone/tablet) of users who browse the Internet when they access some websites and applications. They are used to store and retrieve information about the browsing from that device.

Cookies can be installed either directly by the websites visited or by third parties with which the website has some kind of connection. The website uses the cookies to keep track of the user's activity on the site and others connected with it, for example: the location from which it is accessed, the connection time, the device from which it is accessed (fixed or mobile), the operating system and browser used, the most visited websites, the number of clicks and data on the user's browsing habits.

3. Personal data protection

Under certain circumstances, the use of data storage and recovery devices on recipient terminals, such as cookies, may involve processing personal data. The legitimate grounds for this data processing will be the consent provided by the website or app users after receiving clear and comprehensive information on the use of cookies, in particular regarding the purposes of the data processing, in the area of personal data protection.

To this effect, you must remember that this cookie policy (the "cookie policy") is supplemented by the privacy policy for this website or app.

4. Types of cookies used

This Website uses the following types of cookies:

4.1. Technical and strictly necessary cookies



These are cookies inserted by the publisher which are necessary for the website to operate correctly or to provide a given service requested by the user. Personalisation or preferential cookies are considered necessary to allow information to be recorded so that the user can access the service with certain characteristics which may differentiate their experience from that of other users, such as their preferred language or the number of results to show in their searches.

4.2 Analytical or Performance Cookies

These cookies may be own or third-party cookies and allow the Publisher to monitor and analyse the behaviour of users when they browse the Website or use its services. Except in the case of strictly necessary and technical cookies whose use does not require the user's informed consent, the publisher will place cookies on the user's computer only with the user's prior informed consent. those that they choose in the cookie settings panel displayed by the publisher the first time the user accesses the website or the app.
